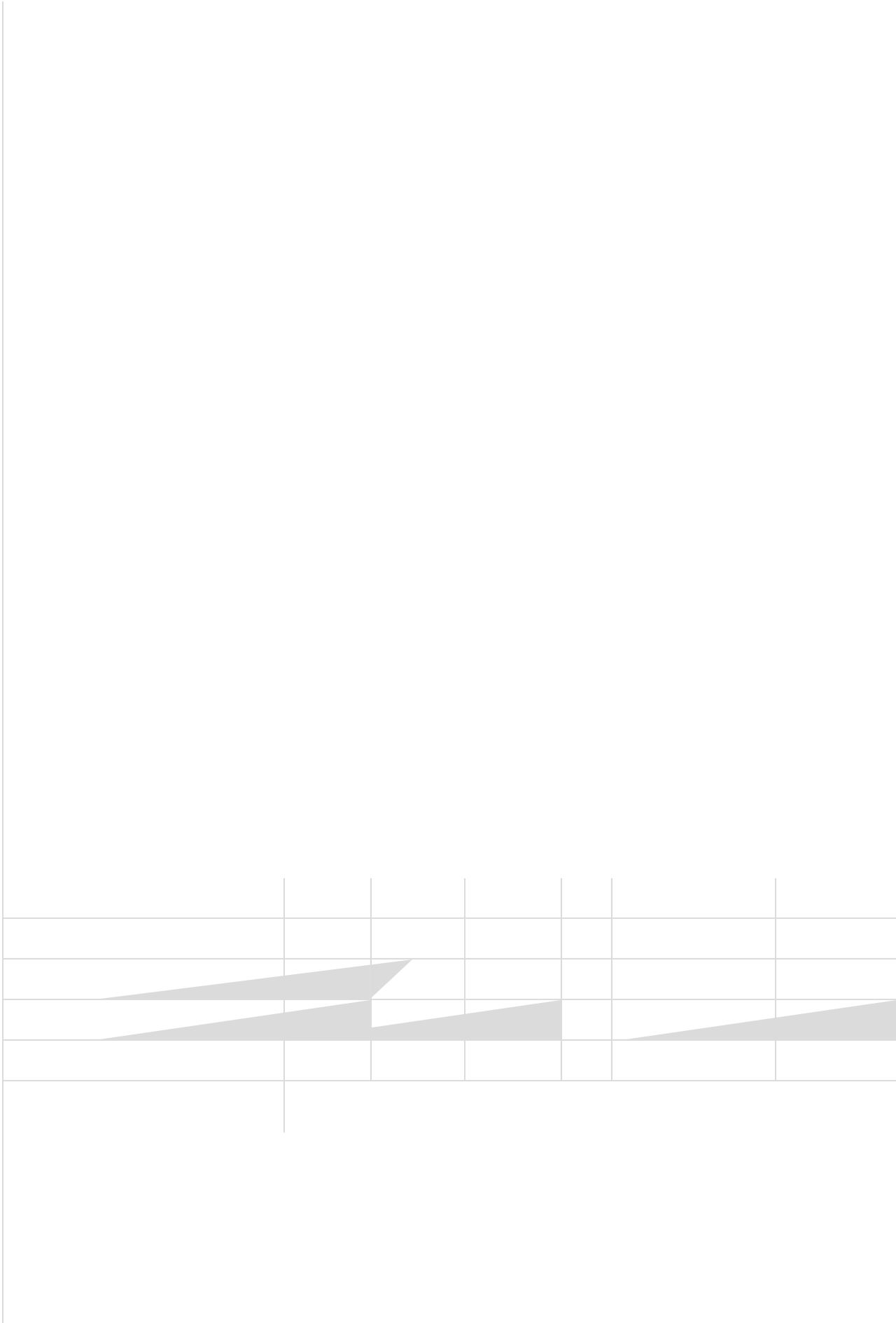

Part A - Fall Enrollment by race/ethnicity and gender



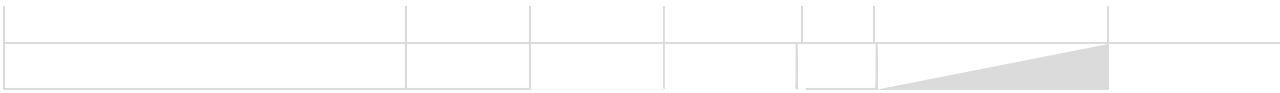
